<u>COURSE DESCRIPTION</u>	This course is designated to complete the study of the required authors for the AP Literature exam. Students will be required to analyze short stories, novels, poems and plays both orally and in written format.

Increase reading vocabulary via Spanish Literature 4. Learn literary terms necessary for the literary analysis Prepare all students to successfully pass the Advanced Placement Exam.	
<u>READING/WRITING COMPONENTS</u>	All readings from textbooks 200 word essays (literary analysis) Supplemental weekend readings	
<u>MATERIAL/RESOURCES</u>	Text issued to each student: “Abriendo Puertas tomos 1 @ 2” Advanced placement materials and sample exams Supplement readings from Gabriel Garcia Marquez and Federico Garcia Lorca	
<u>CLASS RULES</u>	Rules are distributed to students the first day of school . The student signs the rules. Rules are available to parents/guardians on “Back to School Night.	
<u>CLASS ATTENDANCE</u>	Regular attendance is expected for success. If a student is absent, he/she should contact a classmate for missed work. Teacher keeps a notebook where daily assignments are listed. Make-up for quizzes and tests must be completed within two days after returned to school.	
<u>CLASS HOMEWORK POLICY</u>	1. Students are assigned homework nightly. 2. Homework is due at the beginning of the class period. 3. Students are expected to perform daily in class upon teacher request- orally and at the board.

<u>SPECIAL PROJECT DUE:</u>	Final project for second semester in this class is “creacion literaria”. Students are required to write a poem with all the literary concepts learned in the class or write a chapter to follow any of the reading imitating the author’s literary style.
