DEPARTMENT GOAL STATEMENT: Students will master the major concepts and skills of mathematics: number measurement, geometry, patterns and functions, statistics and probability, logic, and algebra. You will reason, invent and construct; achieve a level of understanding that enables them to know how, why, and when to apply their mathematical learning.	

PRIMARY ESLR: The focus of this course will be to develop each student's ability to think logically, and analytically.

<u>COURSE DESCRIPTION</u>	The course is an introduction to advanced math topics, and a course in trigonometry.												
<u>CLASS PROCEDURES</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Class notes and homework problems will be kept in a spiral notebook. The contents will be checked periodically and collected at the end of the quarter. The notebook will be graded for content and organization. ▪ Homework will be checked and graded for completeness at the beginning of the period. Homework must be neat and done in the notebook. Do not tear your assignments from a spiral notebook. Understanding past homework is important and quiz and test questions will be pulled from this material. ▪ Regular quizzes will be given on past homework assignments. ▪ Students are encouraged to quietly ask questions and work with other students. Find a couple of students to work with, who would help you if you get stuck on your homework.
